STAYING SAFE IN THE DRIVE THROUGH AREAS

- Please stay in your vehicle, do not feed or try to touch the animals through your window and please remember that the animals have right of way.
- If stopping, pull over on the left-hand side to allow others to pass. Be aware that Park vehicles drive round the main reserve in the opposite direction so please pull over for oncoming Park vehicles.
- The management cannot accept responsibility for any damage to vehicles in the drive through areas or in the car parks.

ENJOYING THE WALK AROUND AREA

- Please do not feed the animals, climb on walls, cross barriers or bang on windows at exhibits.
- Don't forget that the female polar bear viewing area closes 30 minutes before the Park closes and Wolf Wood closes 15 minutes before the Park closes.
